Description	Interactive PDF e-book of 65 writing prompts and cartoons developed specifically for ELL and literacy learners. Learners can download the PDF and type their stories right into the document offline or while sharing their screen with their tutor.
Media used	Interactive PDF (learner can type in text)
Readability	Good with the following cautions: fonts used in the titles are kind of funky and may be difficult for some learners, introduction at the start has dense text, but it is easy to scroll through to the prompts
Activities included	Each prompt comes with a detailed written segment related to the prompt that may be in the form of a handout, short essay, newspaper clipping, book excerpt or hyperlink
Multisensory	Visuals (cartoon illustrations), T-K (learner enters text using keyboard)
Language level	Early-intermediate (with tutor support) to Advanced
Prerequisites	Open PDF viewer, keyboarding
Recommended Learning Mode	Videoconferencing with shared screen, independent use on laptop or computer (requires several steps and a Google account to fill in the PDF from a smartphone or tablet, so not recommended)
Device compatibility	Laptop, computer
Log-in/subscription	Not required
Cost	Free
Diverse Content	Yes – approach is inclusive of a diverse group of people
Canadian Content	No
Tutor Comment	Very engaging and friendly content. This is both a reading and writing activity and your learner may need support with the reading portion as it is at an intermediate to advanced level. The PDF book can be saved each time so the learner can read back on all their entries.
